You could lend a hand at our Monthly Visitors Evening on the second Tuesday of every month or at our regular Live Craft evenings. You could cook for special events or organize a group to help with seasonal cleaning, painting, gardening, house maintenance and/or an arts & crafts project. You could also create an outside activity for the community - we love anything that involves food, fun and friendship.
